We wanted to share with you the good news of the last two months - but first, a **BIG THANK YOU** for your attendance at the Town of Caledon and Regional Council meetings and the many letters you have sent to let your voice be heard. Your passion and commitment is heartwarming and inspires us to stay the course in the months ahead.

In the last two months much has been accomplished. The Coalition has made presentations to many Councils and Government agencies during that time and the following Councils and Boards all voted unanimously to oppose the Rockfort Quarry application:

- Feb 17th: Erin Town Council
- Feb 20th: Credit Valley Conservation Board
- Mar 3rd: Town of Caledon Council
- Mar 19th: Niagara Escarpment Commission
- Apr 2nd: Region of Peel Council

It is significant that the resolutions passed unanimously, sending a strong message of consensus to the Ontario Municipal Board. The main hearings are scheduled to begin May 25th, 2009.

We still have much work to do making more presentations and preparing for the hearings.
