Region of Peel General Committee receives Staff Planning Report and delegations from JDCL & CCC regarding Rockfort Quarry. Proceedings of the General Committee are typically confirmed at Regional Council.

April 2nd - Peel Votes!

Region of Peel Council votes their position on the Rockfort Quarry.
